#### To purchase a Movie on Pay-Per-View:

[You must purchase the movie before or within 15 minutes of the start time]

- 1. Enter the channel number (or)
- 2. Press Guide
- 3. Use Arrow keys to view movies/events for the day
- 4. Highlight the movie/event you would like to buy(the prices are shown on the guide) and press OK
- 5. You can choose to share with all set top boxes or only the one you are on.
- 6. Enter pin #. The default is 0000. This pin can be changed in the Menu under Settings.
- 7. Select "Purchase"
- 8. The last screen will confirm the purchase and you can begin watching the movie.

#### **Video On Demand:**

- 1. Press the Green VOD button on your remote.
- You may now choose what content you wish to view. Use the arrow buttons on your remote to highlight the category you wish to choose and press OK.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to search and highlight the show or movie you want and press OK. You will now have the option to "Rent" the program. It will ask if you want to share it with your whole home and for a purchase pin. The pin # is defaulted at 0000. You may now watch your movie and the purchase will show on your next month's bill.
- 4. If you would like to change your pin #, go to Menu>Settings>Parental>Change Pin. If you would like to prevent any purchases from being made, please call our office.

# Programming Your Remote Control

- 1. Switch on your device. Then press the TV key.
- 2. Press and hold the RCU SETUP button until the mode key blinks twice.
- 3. Press 991. The mode key blinks twice.
- 4. Aim the remote at the TV and press POWER.
- 5. Press CH+ and CH- repeatedly until the device is switched off.
- 6. Press POWER to turn the TV on.
- 7. Press RCU SETUP to store the code for the TV. The mode key blinks twice. Your remote control is now programmed to operate your TV set.

If these instructions do not work, the remote may need to be set up using the specific code for the TV. Complete brand codes and instructions can be found on our website at www.brucetel.net under the Digital TV tab for the ADB remote programming guide.

#### Input:

To change the input on your Set Top Box (HDMI, A/V, Component, etc.) simply press the STB button (upper right hand corner of your remote) and then press the Input button (lower left hand corner of your remote). If you see "No Signal" on your TV, the most likely cause is that the input has been changed.

# Turn on your TV using the Remote Control:

Press the white TV button on the upper left corner of the remote. Press the Power button. To control the set top box, press the STB button and then continue use as normal.

# Finding a Channel/Program or Changing Channels:

- 1. Enter the desired channel number OR
- 2. Press channel up/down OR
- 3. Press Guide to view a complete list of channels. Scroll through the channel line up using the up/down arrow keys located around the OK button or using the channel up/down button. Select the desired channel by pressing OK. To scroll by page, use the page + or button located below the OK button.

#### **Menu Button:**

TV - This gives you Guide options, Search options, and the What's Hot app.
Recordings - takes you to your DVR Recordings On Demand - Video On Demand content Phone - Shows your Recent calls and System Messages

Apps - Games, Weather, and What's Hot apps Settings - Settings for Apps, Display, Favorites, Guide, Parental Controls, Phone (caller ID on TV), and Recordings.

## **Closed Captioning:**

Closed captioning will need to be enabled when wanted and disabled when not. To enable the Closed Captioning, go to Menu>Settings > Display>Turn Closed Captioning on. To turn it back off, go to Menu>Settings> Display>Turn Closed Captioning off.

#### **During Live TV:**

Press OK to view a Mini Bar across the top of the screen with the channel number and description, date, time, and temperature.

Press the **forward arrow** (to the right of the **OK** button) to view a status bar of the show you are watching that also includes the channel number and description, date, time and temperature.

## **Shortcuts During Live TV:**

- Red Button Shortcut to the Weather App
- Green Button Shortcut to your call log of recent calls
- Yellow Button Shortcut to Apps
- < Left Arrow Allows you to search for a program by name.
- > Right Arrow View the name of the program you are viewing and a status bar along with current weather conditions. If you use the right arrow you can view what's coming up next on that channel.

#### **Restart TV:**

From the Guide: Programs that have a green arrow on the left side have the ability to restart (watch the show from the very beginning even if it is half-way through or almost over). Press the Green button to start the show from the start. Depending on which Set Top Box you have, you will have the ability to fast-forward through the commercials when you restart the program.



#### **DVR Function Buttons:**

The DVR function buttons are located toward the top of the remote and include: Rewind, Fast Forward, Stop, Record, Skip back, and Skip ahead. Use these function buttons to control the LIVE program you are currently watching.

## To Record A Program:

From live TV: Press the red Record button and a menu will pop up to choose a one-time, series recording, or set a reminder or auto-tune. From the Guide: Highlight the program you wish to record and press OK or the red Record button and a menu will pop up to choose a one-time, series recording, or set a reminder or auto-tune.

# **To View A Recorded Program:**

Press DVR List button. Highlight the program you wish to watch and press OK or you can choose one of the following options from the bottom of the screen:

- 1. Delete delete the recording
- 2. Actions allows you to edit the item, group recordings, or move to a folder.
- 3. Search search for shows with the same title
- 4. Sort sort your recordings by name or date

## Setting a Reminder/Auto-tune:

From live TV: Press the red Record button, arrow over to the Reminder option. Here you can choose your reminder options and set up an auto-tune.

From the Guide: Highlight the program you would like to set a reminder for, press the red Record button or the OK button, arrow over to the Reminder option. Here you can choose your reminder options and set up an auto-tune.
